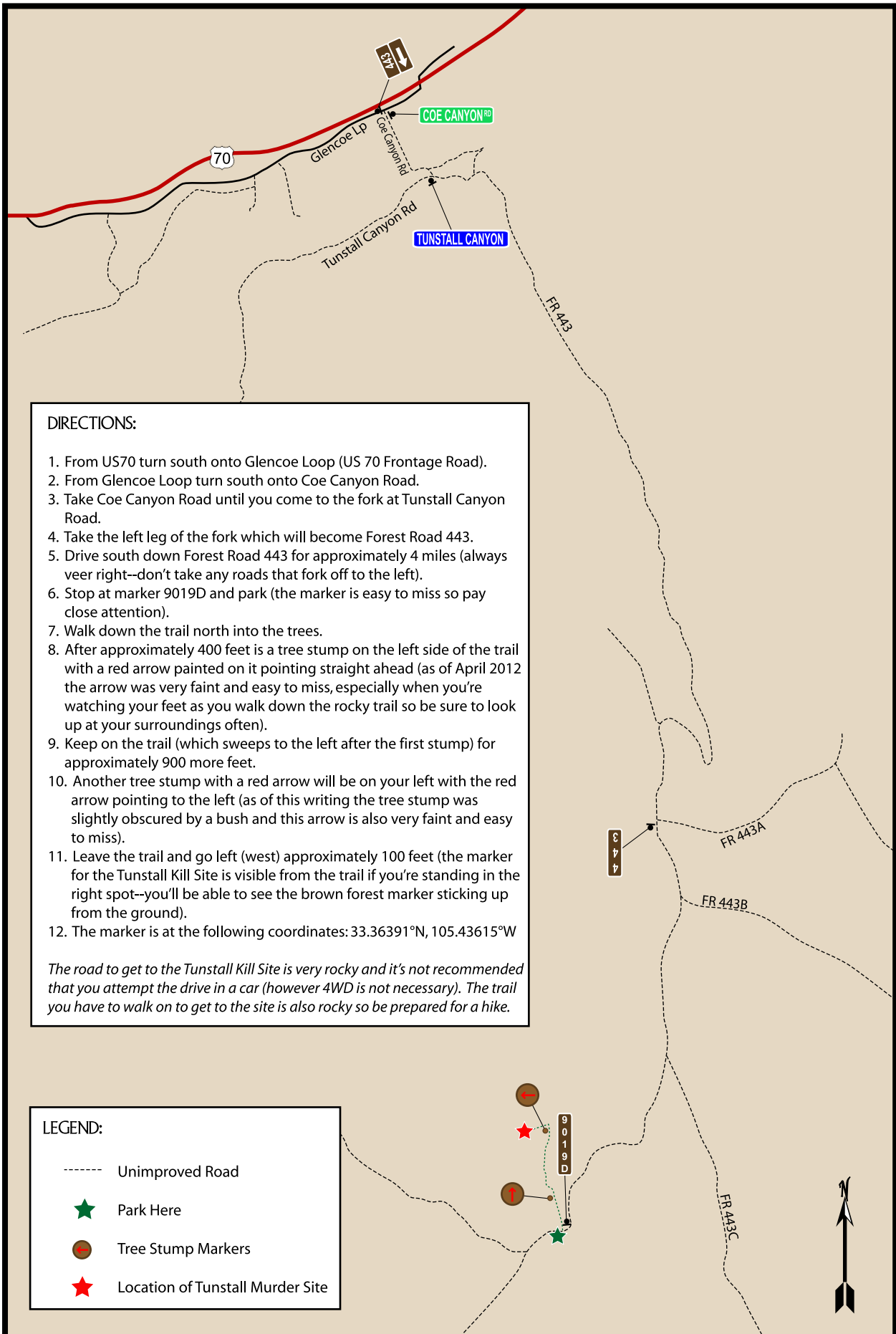


# Tunstall Kill Site



## DIRECTIONS:

1. From US70 turn south onto Glencoe Loop (US 70 Frontage Road).
2. From Glencoe Loop turn south onto Coe Canyon Road.
3. Take Coe Canyon Road until you come to the fork at Tunstall Canyon Road.
4. Take the left leg of the fork which will become Forest Road 443.
5. Drive south down Forest Road 443 for approximately 4 miles (always veer right--don't take any roads that fork off to the left).
6. Stop at marker 9019D and park (the marker is easy to miss so pay close attention).
7. Walk down the trail north into the trees.
8. After approximately 400 feet is a tree stump on the left side of the trail with a red arrow painted on it pointing straight ahead (as of April 2012 the arrow was very faint and easy to miss, especially when you're watching your feet as you walk down the rocky trail so be sure to look up at your surroundings often).
9. Keep on the trail (which sweeps to the left after the first stump) for approximately 900 more feet.
10. Another tree stump with a red arrow will be on your left with the red arrow pointing to the left (as of this writing the tree stump was slightly obscured by a bush and this arrow is also very faint and easy to miss).
11. Leave the trail and go left (west) approximately 100 feet (the marker for the Tunstall Kill Site is visible from the trail if you're standing in the right spot--you'll be able to see the brown forest marker sticking up from the ground).
12. The marker is at the following coordinates: 33.36391°N, 105.43615°W

*The road to get to the Tunstall Kill Site is very rocky and it's not recommended that you attempt the drive in a car (however 4WD is not necessary). The trail you have to walk on to get to the site is also rocky so be prepared for a hike.*
